









Port of Keelung

Port of Keelung is located at the northern top of Taiwan and is the busiest port as well as the most important cruise home port of Taiwan. 

Keelung Miaokou Night Market 1.5km(7mins)

Keelung Miaokou Night Market is close to Keelung Train station where you can sample a variety of well-known snacks such as tempura, thickened soup and other authentic cuisine.



Yehliu Geopark 15.8km(30mins)

Yehliu Geopark is a world renowned landscape attraction of honeycomb and rocks eroded by the sea. Here you can see "Queen's head", "fairy shoes", "mushroom stone" and "candlestick" stone formations.



Taipei 101 28.5km(28mins)

Located in the central business district of Taipei, Taipei 101 is the tallest building in Taiwan and is an iconic landmark with shopping malls and an observation deck.



National Palace Museum 29.2km(40mins)

The National Palace Museum in Taiwan known for its "Chinese Cultural Treasure", are recognized as the world's five major museums along with the Louvre in France, the British Museum in England, Hermitage Museum in Russia and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York, USA.






Port of Taichung



National Taichung Theater 37.4km(45mins)

The distinctive National Taichung Theater is a large-scale public performance space, built with the architectural concept of "caves" and "crypts" used in the prehistoric area and can accommodate over 3,000 people.



MITSUI OUTLET PARK Taichungport 1km(3mins)

MITSUI OUTLET PARK Taichungport is the first Outlet Park which is located in Harbor area in Taiwan. There is a Ferris Wheel stands on the seashore, and the shopping zone is combined with the elements of marine, travel, fashion, living, and entertainment.



Gaomei Wetlands Preservation Area 9km(17mins)

Gaomei Wetlands Preservation Area is a coastal wetland formed by the convergence of fresh and sea water by the Dajia River estuary and forms a natural habitat for wild animals and various flora.



Lukang Old Street 31.8km (35mins)

Lukang Old Street is an old red brick pathway with well-preserved historic buildings, traditional snacks, temples and a gateway to experience the history and culture of southern Taiwan.

Port of Kaohsiung is the largest and the most important commercial port in Taiwan. With an excellent location in downtown Kaohsiung, as well as rich tourist attractions in the neighboring cities and counties, it attracts international cruise ships and has become the second largest cruise home port in Taiwan. There are two cruise terminals at port of Kaohsiung, Kaohsiung Port Cruise Terminal and Kaohsiung Peng Lai Cruise Terminal, which provide passengers with sophisticated customs clearance facilities and services.





Fo Guang Shan Buddha Museum 39.7km(50mins)

Fo Guang Shan Buddha Museum is a Buddhist cultural, religious and educational museum overlooking the Gaoping River and the diagonal bridge. The exhibition hall of the museum often holds various exhibitions and is a scenic and sacred place to experience Buddhist culture.



Lianchihtan 9.5km(30mins)

Stroll along the scenic trail around the Lianchihtan and enjoy the lotus blossom as well as several watersports and other surrounding attractions such as Dragon and Tiger Pagodas, Confucius Temple, Spring and Autumn Pavilions.



Great Harbor Bridge 2.2km(9mins)

Taiwan's first swing bridge. It is also the longest swing bridge in Asia. The bridge's profile, meant to evoke the image of a beautifully contoured seashell or a porpoise arcing just above the surface of the sea, is in aesthetic harmony with the whale motif of the nearby Kaohsiung Music Center. Also, the bridge's sleek, flowing lines are designed to help visitors imagine themselves aboard a luxurious yacht at sea.



Pier-2 Art Center 2.6km(10mins)

Originally a barge dock in Port of Kaohsiung, it has now been transformed into a creative and multi-functional space for various shows and art installations.






Port of Hualien

The Oceanic Gateway to Hualien & Taitung

Port of Hualien is an artificial harbor perfectly sheltered by the combination of east and west breakwaters. Hualien Harbor Passenger Clearance Station is located at Pier23, which have natural deep-water advantages and can accommodate cruise ships of up to 225,000 Tons. With the Pacific Ocean to the east offering natural beauty, foreign visitors often visit Taroko National Park amongst other must-visit attractions.



Chisingtan Scenic Area 6.9km(16mins)

Enjoy the scenic trails overlooking the majestic Pacific Ocean coast.



Qingshui Cliff 34.3km(48mins)

Located along the Suhua highway lies Qingshui Cliff, overlooking the Pacific Ocean on one side and Taiwan's magnificent mountains on the other.



Taroko National Park 25.4km(39mins)

Landmark gorge featuring marbled canyons and majestic landscapes with magnificent cliffs, caves, waterfalls and other scenic spots such as the Shakadang Trail, Swallow Grotto Trail, Bruwan Trail.



Chingsiu Temple 9.2km(26mins)

Built during the Japanese colonial period, Chingsiu Temple is a traditional Japanese monastery that has 88 Buddha sculptures and steles featuring a zen courtyard.

Chihkan Tower 5.5km(16mins)

Built in 1653 during the Dutch occupation, the park is rich in cultural and historic sites with the surrounding area also featuring famous Taiwanese snacks and places of worship. A perfect site suitable for walking and exploring the beauty of this ancient capital.



Anping Old fort 5.4km(16mins)

Built in 1624 by the Dutch, Anping fort is the first castle in Taiwan converted from "Zeelandia". Depicted on the wall are stories of previous wars fought and also feature several nearby attractions such as Anping Old Street, Anping Tree House and Tait Marketing & Distribution Co., Ltd.



Tainan Confucian Temple 5.2km(15mins)

Tainan Confucian Temple is Taiwan's first Confucian temple known as "Premier Academy of Taiwan", showcasing a number of royal plaques of various emperors.




Chimei Museum 14.2km(34mins)








Explore the Island of Gaillardia Flowers




Main Attractions


Daguoye Columnar Basalt 29.3km(45mins)

Penghu has spectacular Basalt columns, which give visitors an out of the world experience when viewing the column reflections on the water especially after a rainy day or in the early morning.


Erkan Historic Village 28.3km(43mins)

Showing centuries of community culture through ancient relics and wares. The Chen family historic residence is built using local coral stones and natural Basalt resources showing traditional craftsmanship.


Mt. Kueibi 14.4km(28mins)

During low tides, a secret shoal would appear beneath the waves and allow visitors to walk across to the rock on the opposite of Mt. Kueibi. When the tides revert back, the shoal is hidden for another day's mystery.


Twin Heart Stone Weir 56km(1hr30mins)

Easily accessible by ferry from Magong Pier District, visitors can reach Qimei Island and visit this famous attraction. This site was originally constructed for fishing purposes against the tide and the unique heart shaped formation and crashing of waves, makes this the perfect spot for romance.
